

HDFC Bank partners with Jammu Police for ‘Traffic Paathshala’

- ***Campaign to educate people on Do’s and Don’ts of road safety***

Jammu, February 11, 2020: HDFC Bank has partnered with J&K Police to launch a road safety initiative in the city. Called ‘Traffic Paathshala,’ the initiative aims to make roads safer by creating awareness on the Do’s and Don’ts of road safety.

The awareness rally which includes groups of volunteers and HDFC Bank employees would be covering all important and busy traffic junctions across the city. These volunteers would carry branded placards having traffic awareness messages to encourage people to follow road safety rules. While the volunteers will reward the motorists found observing traffic discipline with a token of appreciation, the others found violating will be enrolled in the ‘Traffic Paathshala’ and will be informed about the Do’s and Don’ts of road safety.

Some of the important road safety rules:

- Wearing Helmets / Seat Belts while driving
- Adhering to signals and lane discipline
- Not using mobile phone while driving
- Having all necessary documents in place



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This initiative is in line with the recent Indian Motor Vehicle Act introduced by the Indian Government to make our roads safer.
