A programme dedicated to the youth of the state is going to be held on Saturday, February 4, at the Nehru Nagar Police Ground in the capital. These youth have to work in the youth internship programme for 6 months from this month itself, in which they are going to learn the qualities of good governance. This ambitious scheme, named Mukhya Mantri Janseva Mitra, is being considered as the only and innovative scheme of not only in the country but the world. The enthusiasm shown by the private and government companies of the country and the world regarding the scheme has made this event even more special. Lghts in Bhopal Municipal Corporation offices go off

The 'lights' of the Municipal Corporation offices in Bhopal have again gone off. The power company disconnected the power connections of the office and zone offices located at Mata Mandir. Due to this the lift has also stopped. Regarding this, Corporation President Kishan Suryavanshi termed action by the power company incorrect. Due to non-availability of electricity, the work of common people is also held up.

this action for not depositing the electricity bill. Due to this, the lights in the office located at Mata Mandir remained switched off for two days. People's representatives are also facing problems. Apart from this, lights have also gone off in Zone-2 and its ward offices. For two days there is no electricity in these four offices and also in the computer branch located at Annapurna Bhavan. Work also came to a standstill due to a power failure. The matter of non-payment of dues between the Municipal Corporation and the Electricity Company often comes to the fore. The

company many a times disconnects the connection of street lights of the corporation. Last year, from October 29, the company had disconnected the connections of street lights for 12 consecutive days. Due to this, the lights of most areas of the city were turned off. These included many major roads, over which lakhs of people pass everyday. In-charge minister Bhopendra Singh had to come forward on this issue. He called a meeting of the officers of both the departments and got the connections connected.

Suryavanshi has expressed displeasure due to power failure of corporation officers. He told that the Municipal Corporation owes the amount to the electricity company. The corporation deposits the amount in instalments. Despite this, the company disconnected the connection. This behavior is not right. He further said that the corporation office is the center of public convenience. The corporation also has to recover the dues from the company, but the corporation never locked the doors. If the attitude remains the same, we will also act strictly.

Remuneration for the doctors of open market:- ₹ 75000/- for general Duty Doctor, if Govt. accommodation is not provided. If Railway accommodation is provided, an amount equivalent to the sum of House Rent Allowance and License Fee of the accommodation provided will be deducted. **Age for other than retired railway doctors:** Candidate should not have completed more than 60 years of age as on 10.02.2023. However, age relaxation of 5 year for SC/ST and 3 years for OBC candidate is admissible. **Age for Retired Railway doctor:** Candidates should not have completed more than 67 years of age as on 10.02.2023. **Terms and condition of other than retired railway doctors:** the engagement of Doctors would be on contract basis initially for a period of one year, which is extendable on annual basis up to a maximum 12 (Twelve) terms or till attaining the age of 65 years whichever ever earlier as per administrative requirements on the basis of assessment of performance of CMPs. However, the services of these doctors can be terminated before the expiry of one year after giving 15 days notice on either side. Railway Administration will be at liberty to terminate the contract of the doctor with immediate effect by paying honorarium in lieu of 15 days notice period, if the circumstances, so warrant. The services rendered as contract doctor is a stop gap arrangement and will not have any bearing in respect of consideration of their period in case of their subsequent regular selection through UPSC. It will also not confer upon them any right for regularization or permanent absorption in the Railways. Contract shall also be terminated, if the CMP is found to be mentally or physically incapacitated. **No private practice is allowed. Terms and condition for Retired Railway doctors:-** The engagement of Retired Doctors as CMPs shall be for a Maximum of 07 (seven) terms or till attaining the age of 67 years whichever is earlier on each term of engagement shall not exceed more than one year, a fresh contract shall be entered. The contract shall be entered into for a period of one year or less from the date of entering into the contract. Period of contract shall not be extendable on any ground. However, the Railway administration shall reserve the right to enter into fresh contract with the Retired Govt. Medical officer of state Govt./ Central Govt./ IRHS officers (Railways) for another term. The engagement shall purely is on contract basis for a period of one year or till the regular incumbent joins or on Retired Govt. Medical officers of state Govt./ Central Govt./ IRHS officers (Railways) attaining the age of 65 years whichever is earlier. The Retired Govt. Medical officers of state Govt./ Central Govt./ IRHS officers (Railways) engaged as Contract Medical practitioner shall not have any claim or right for his/her continuity in service or automatic extension of the term of contract. During the validity of the contract, the CMP shall be at liberty to terminate the contract for betterment of his/her career or on any other grounds by giving 15 days notice to the Railways. The contract can also be terminated by the Railways at any time during the contract by giving 15 days notice without assigning any reason whatsoever. Contract shall also be terminated, if the CMP is found to be mentally or physically incapacitated. **No private practice is allowed.**

Note:- (i) The contract Doctors shall not be entitled for Railway quarter etc. as a matter of right. However, if such a quarter is available, they will be provided accommodation. The detailed instructions with regard to their duties while on contract with the Railways shall be given to them in the event of their selection along with the offer of engagement.
