SC showed respect for 'Bhartiya' family system: RSS-linked organisation on ruling on same-sex marriages

NEW DELHI, OCT 18 --/ RSS-linked Samvardhinee Nyas, a women's organisation, has welcomed the Supreme Court's decision on same-sex marriages, saying the top court has shown respect for the "Bhartiya family and marriage system".

A five-judge Constitution bench of the Supreme Court on Tuesday refused to grant legal recognition to same-sex marriages. Chief Justice of India D Y Chandrachud, who was heading the bench pronouncing its verdict on 21 pleas seeking legal validation for same-sex marriages, said the court cannot make a law but only interpret it, and it is for Parliament to change the Special Marriage Act. "Samvardhinee Nyas has welcomed the Supreme Court's decision not to give legal recognition to same-sex marriage and adoption," the RSS-linked organisation said in a statement late on Tuesday. The organisation believes that "the Honorable Supreme Court has respected Bhartiya family and marriage system by giving the decision that the relationship between two homosexuals in the form of marriage, is not eligible for registration. This is not even their fundamental right", it said.

"Denying homosexuals the right to adopt a child is also a good decision," the statement said, adding that "Samvardhinee Nyas believes that the Supreme Court will always stand to protect Bhartiya Sanskriti and its values in the larger interest of society". (PTI)

Narcotics, psychological warfare biggest challenges to humanity: J&K LG SRINAGAR, OCT 18 --/ Asserting that narcotics and psychological warfare are the biggest challenges before humanity, Jammu and Kashmir Lieutenant Governor Manoj Sinha on Wednesday said police need to effectively counter these dangers.

Sinha said a zero-tolerance policy needs to be adopted against the subversive elements in the Union Territory. "There are many challenges in front of you. Today, the biggest danger is narcotics and psychological warfare. These two are the biggest challenges to humanity," he said, addressing the passing-out parade of 510 new recruits of the Jammu and Kashmir Police in the Sheeri area of Baramulla district. Sinha said the security forces need to effectively counter these challenges by remaining alert and devising a strategy. He said Jammu and Kashmir has become stronger in the last three years on many fronts, including economic, social and cultural. (PTI)

Oppn UDF lays siege to Kerala Secretariat; claims corruption, mismanagement by Left govt

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM, OCT 18 --/ The Congress-led UDF on Wednesday laid siege to the Kerala Secretariat here, accusing the Left government of corruption, administrative mismanagement and financial extravagance.

The UDF alleged the state government's misrule has suspended development and welfare measures in the state. Leader of Opposition in the state assembly V D Satheesan alleged that "looters were ruling the state". He said this while inaugurating the protest outside the Secretariat where UDF leaders, workers and supporters turned up in large numbers since early morning. He alleged that despite the state being in financial troubles there was no reduction in the extravagant expenditures by the government. The LoP contended that pension and DA arrears were yet to be paid, KSRTC drivers and conductors have not received

salaries for the last couple of months and farmers haven't been paid for grains collected from them. Satheesan claimed that crores were spent on "welcoming a crane" at Vizhinjam port, holding district review meetings across the state and conducting the upcoming week-long Kerala Eeyam celebrations from November 1.

November 1 marks the formation day of the state. He also listed out the various instances of alleged corruption by the government which included the Karuvannur bank scam case, installation of Artificial Intelligence (AI) cameras and the KFON project. Satheesan also attacked CM Pinarayi Vijayan over financial transactions of his daughter's firm with a private company. Kerala Pradesh Congress Committee (KPCC) chief K Sudhakaran also spoke along similar lines at the protest in

the heart of the capital where UDF protestors blocked access to three of the four entry gates to the Secretariat building. However, the working of the Secretariat was not affected as the Vijayan-led state cabinet held a meeting on various issues. Sudhakaran, also an MP, claimed that there was no law or justice in the state and alleged that under no CM has the state suffered so much as it is doing now.

Attacking Vijayan, he alleged that his government was defective and that he has not been able to achieve anything despite getting a second term in power. The KPCC chief said that by comparison, former Kerala CM Oommen Chandy had hundreds of achievements to his credit. All Congress leaders, including Satheesan, Sudhakaran and Congress MP K Muraliedharan, said even the Vizhinjam port was the outcome of the efforts of Chandy. (PTI)
