For the purpose, 25 teams — comprising five members each would conduct the culling operation in the Alfa and Royal Poultry Farms in Dera Bassi's

Behra village. "Culling, which is the mainstay of stopping the spread of the virus, will commence in the two affected poultry farms of Dera Bassi on January 22," said Mohali Deputy Commissioner Girish Dayalan.

"Culling of over 50,000 birds is expected to be undertaken at the affected epicenter. Twenty-five teams would con-

Civil surgeons directed to include more sites, beneficiaries to accelerate vaccination drive

To accelerate the corona vac-L cination drive across the State, Punjab Health and Family Welfare Minister Balbir Singh Sidhu on Thursday instructed all the Civil Surgeons to extend the number of sites as well as beneficiaries.

Punjab Government has already increased the vaccination sites from 59 to 134 so as to ensure maximum coverage of government and private healthcare providers," said Sidhu while presiding over the Civil Surgeons Review meeting at the Punjab Bhawan.

He said that the feature of 'Allot Beneficiary' in an ongoing session has been added in the vaccinator module and is live. "The feature has been added to facilitate maximum utilization of staff deployed at the session sites so that they can cater to the optimal number of beneficiaries (healthcare providers) per session," he said.

He added that earlier, only such additional beneficiaries could be added whose names already existed in the database generated by CoWIN portal for a particular session, "but now, there is a provision to add new beneficiaries at the sites as well for inclusion in ongoing session". Sidhu said that the State received 2.04 lakh doses of Covishiled vaccine on January 12, 2021, and 1.96 lakh doses on January 19, 2021, while a total of 12,467 benefi-

"Keep working properly on a routine vaccination program under which pregnant women and children are being vaccinated," he said adding that departmental efforts should prevent the wastage of vaccines and it has to be minimized at all levels in the hos-

ciaries vaccinated so far.

Hussan Lal said that they have to hold the meeting with District Immunization Officers daily and also with the session site in-charges and the vaccine cold chain point in-charges.

He clarified that if any eligible beneficiary failed to get himself registered at CoWin portal, he or she can easily enroll for the free vaccination even now. All drug warehouses have a sufficient stock of Corona Fateh Kits which has proved a boon for the speedy

recovery of COVID positive patients, he added.

At the same time, he instructed the Civil Surgeons to deliver the Fateh kits to patients kept under the home isolation without any delay and the Civil Surgeons should personally cross-check the functioning of COVID Program and then submit the report to the head-

COVID VACCINATION DRIVE GAINS MOMEN-TUM IN MOHALI

Overcoming the initial hesitation and qualms, the COVID-19 vaccination is now gaining momentum in Mohali district. "The loan was secured by mortgaging property in the Sonepat to UCO Bank as collateral security. Later it was found that the alleged has already availed another loan of



Rs four crores from Corporation Bank, Mayapuri by mortgaging the same property. The fact regarding mortgaging the said property to Corporation Bank, Mayapuri was concealed by accused Satish Kumar from the UCO Bank," said the Joint CP.

"During investigation it was revealed that the sale deed of property submitted by the alleged Satish Sharma to the UCO Bank as security did not

match with the record of Sub-Registrar, Sonepat. It was found that Suresh Pruthi who originally sold the property to Satish Sharma in 1998 has also signed forged papers of Sale Deed of the property on which Satish Sharma availed a loan of Rs two crore from UCO Bank," said the Joint CP.

"The accused Pruthi was arrested on January 20 by the EOW police team," said the Ioint CP.
