

Most colleges unlikely to reopen today amid confusion over guidelines

THOUGH TUESDAY is supposed to mark return of college and university students to classrooms after one-and-a-half years, confusion

over guidelines and last minute instructions may lead to a delay in reopening physical classes.

Even though the local disaster management authority has declared that higher educational institutions can start offline lectures from October 12, lack of instruc-

tions from the Savitribai Phule Pune University to affiliated colleges means they will remain shut.

NS Umrani, pro-vice chancellor, SPPL, said no instructions can be issued from the university to colleges since the higher education department has still not issued any order. "The disaster man-

agement authority has given permission but we are yet to get any instructions from the state higher education department. It's not just about reopening colleges but Covid SOPs need to be revisited and issued to colleges..." he said.

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Burglars use SUV to dislodge ATM cash dispenser

PUNE RURAL Police are investigating two back-to-back cases of ATM break-ins in which an SUV was used by burglars to dislodge the cash dispenser with a rope before fleeing with units containing large sums of cash. Investigation teams suspect the same set of perpetrators are involved in both the cases.

In the latest of the two heists, robbers targeted an ATM kiosk in Daund taluka of Pune district, where they dislodged the cash dispenser machine with the help of a rope and pulled it with an SUV. The dispenser contained

more than Rs 6.42 lakh cash. The suspects had blackened the security cameras with spray paint prior to dislodging the machine. This break-in had striking similarities to another incident that took place in the jurisdiction of Shirur police station four days ago -- an SUV of the same make, same modus operandi and same swiftness of execution.

The ATM kiosk in Daund is of a non-banking payment services provider headquartered in Mumbai and was operated by a local franchise owner. The heist, which occurred around 3 am on Sunday, did not come to light till Sunday afternoon, when a State Home Guard personnel passing through the area informed the

police about broken glass and other scattered objects outside the ATM kiosk. An FIR was registered at Daund police station in Pune rural jurisdiction. Officials said the burglars could not have executed the heist without detailed knowledge of the surroundings, possibly gathered by doing a recon of the area.

Inspector Vinod Ghuge, in-charge of Daund police station, said, "There were no security guards on duty at the ATM nor was there an alarm system."

Inspector Sureshkumar Raut, in-charge of Shirur police station, said, "There are several similarities between the case in Daund and the one in our jurisdiction four days ago. Same make of SUV

used, timing of the heist and the very short time in which the suspects executed the burglary. It is possible that the same set of perpetrators are behind both the break-ins. We are coordinating with the investigation team in Daund." The ATM in Shirur belonged to a different non-banking entity and was operated by a local franchise owner.

Pune Rural jurisdiction's Superintendent of Police Abhinav Deshmukh said, "These cases from Daund and Shirur are being jointly probed. We have observed that many ATMs do not have adequate security measures, guards or alarms systems..."

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Student body writes to CM, seeks action against PCMC chief for 'rude behaviour'

DAYS AFTER he was accused of high-handedness after getting nine protesting citizens and a corporator arrested, Pimpri-Chinchwad Municipal Commissioner Rajesh Patil has once again courted controversy -- this time by allegedly behaving in an "arrogant and rude" manner with a few students. Following the alleged incident, which was also video-recorded, the students have written to Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray and the Urban Development Department (UDD) seeking stern action against the commissioner.

Members of the Rayat Vidyarthi Parishad, a student body, said that they had approached Patil to complain about the "inordinate delay" in conducting tree census on the part of the contractor appointed by the civic administration when the commissioner behaved rudely with them. Raviraj Kale, secretary of the Parishad, told the Indian Express on Monday, "We decided to meet him personally as he had repeatedly avoided replying to our complaint. We had written at least 6-7 letters to him."

In the video uploaded on Facebook by the students, Patil is heard telling them that he was not accountable to them.

When the students alleged

that Pimpri-Chinchwad Municipal Corporation (PCMC) was favouring a "guilty contractor", the commissioner is heard saying, "You can think whatever you want to." When the students persist, he is heard saying, "I am accountable to the PCMC."

Kale said the PCMC had failed to conduct the tree census from 2015 to 2017. "Former municipal commissioner Shrawan Hardikar had, on January 11, 2018, ordered a tree census. The private contractor was given a tender of Rs 6.80 crore for carrying out the census in two years. However, the work still remains incomplete."

When asked to respond to the students' allegations, Patil said, "It's not true... I have not behaved the way they are alleging."

Last month, Patil had filed a police complaint against nine citizens and a corporator, Asha Shendge, who were protesting against the condition of road outside their houses. One of the citizens had allegedly thrown ink on his nameplate. After Patil's complaint, the 10 were arrested.

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Man arrested for killing brother in '19, aide also held

Pune: Pune rural police recently arrested a man for allegedly murdering his brother two years back following a dispute over their mutual liking for a girl.

An offence of murder has been lodged at Paud police station against accused Yogesh Vilas Idhole (21).

Police said Yogesh, a resident of Washim in Akola district, was in love with a local girl. His brother Gajanan also liked the same girl, which had led to tension between the siblings, police added. In November 2019, Yogesh invited Gajanan to meet their mother at Jatode village in Mulshi in Pune district and late took him to a farmland on the pretext of a liquor party, police said. Yogesh then allegedly killed Gajanan by hitting him with a hard object before proceeding to bury his body on the spot with the help of a friend, who was a 17-year-old at that time, they added.

In the meantime, the woman got married to another man in Akola but Yogesh allegedly contacted her and threatened to circulate her "obscene photographs" on social media, police said. The woman informed her mother about the threat following which she contacted the police, they added.

A team from Paud police station, headed by senior inspector Ashok Dhuma, arrested Yogesh and during interrogation, he revealed his role in his brother's murder, police said. **ENS**
