(B) a person who has come to or stays in India, in either case, otherwise than-
 a. for or on taking up employment in India, or b. for carrying on in India a business or vocation in India, or c. for any other purpose, in such circumstances as would indicate his intention to stay in India for an uncertain period;"
I understand that the Bank is/will be releasing foreign exchange to me under the Liberalised Remittance Scheme based on my above declaration. I further understand that I shall be solely liable to any penal action that may arise, in terms of the provisions of Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999, in the event of my above declaration being found incorrect.
