

# Ambani security: NIA seizes 2 more vehicles used by Waze

AS PART of its investigation into the Ambani security scare case, the National Investigation Agency (NIA) on Thursday seized two more vehicles — a Toyota Land Cruiser Prado and a Mercedes — that were used by suspended Assistant Police Inspector (API) Sachin Waze.

One of these vehicles, the Prado, is registered in the name of one Bhosle Vijaykumar Ganpat, who in 2014 had contested the Maharashtra Legislative Assembly elections from Guhagar on a Shiv Sena ticket. The registration number of the Prado — MH02CC 101 — is mentioned by Bhosle in the affidavit he filed while contesting for the Assembly elections.

NIA officers refused to comment on the issue. Sources said the officers are looking for two more vehicles in connection with the case.

Bhosle was not available for comment on how his vehicle was in Waze's possession.

Sofar, the NIA has seized four vehicles in the case and is believed to be on the lookout for more vehicles.

An NIA official said, "These vehicles were used by Waze and have been seized as part of our investigation." An officer said that the Prado vehicle is believed to have been used by Waze when he drove down Mansukh Hiran from Thane to Mumbai Police headquarters for ques-

tioning.

Hiran used the Scorpio vehicle that was kept outside the Ambani residence Antilia with gelatin sticks and a threat letter on March 25. Hiran was later found dead in Mumbra creek on March 5.

Earlier, the NIA had seized the Scorpio vehicle that was placed outside the Ambani residence and a Mercedes that was believed to have been used by Waze.

From the Mercedes vehicle, the NIA had found Rs 5 lakh cash, a currency counting machine and kerosene.

While the NIA is currently investigating the Ambani terror scare case, there are indications that the Hiran murder case would also be taken over by NIA, sources said. The cases are said to be linked, due to which NIA may take over the other case too.

The Thane court last week rejected Waze's interim bail plea, stating that the case is at an initial stage and needs a thorough investigation. ENS

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A senior officer from ATS confirmed that they will be seeking Waze's custody on Friday.

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## ATS to seek Waze custody in Hiran case

**Mumbai:** The Maharashtra ATS is on Friday likely to seek a production warrant to take suspended API Sachin Waze into its custody as an accused in the murder case of Thane auto dealer Mansukh Hiran.

The ATS, seeking his custody, will imply that Waze will be named as an accused in Hiran's murder case. Currently, he is in NIA custody in the Ambani threat case.

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# 'Mistakes committed by his officers serious... that's why he was transferred'

HOME MINISTER Anil Deshmukh on Wednesday said that transfer of Mumbai Police commissioner Param Bir Singh was not a routine administrative move and the decision was taken after probe revealed "serious errors" in the commissioner's office.

"This was not an administrative transfer. There are certain things that have come forward during the National Investigation Agency (NIA) and state Anti-Terrorism Squad (ATS) investigations. Being the head of the Mumbai Police force, some serious mistakes have been committed by his officers working in the commissioner's office. These mistakes are serious and unforgivable and that is the reason he was transferred," Deshmukh said at an event organised by a Marathi newspaper in Mumbai.

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investigations, certain details have emerged that were "unforgivable" and in order to ensure that a fair and transparent inquiry was conducted, Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray, in consultation with him, had de-

cid to transfer Singh. "Singh was the Mumbai Police commissioner and this incident happened in his own office. His assistant police inspector-level officer, his subordinates and a driver have been named in

the investigation. The decision to remove him was taken to ensure that the investigation being conducted is clean and there are no hurdles," Deshmukh said.

He added that while the involvement of some police officers in the case had come to the fore, "no one — be they junior or senior, who was guilty, would be spared". The reshuffle in the state police came three days after the NIA arrested Assistant Police Inspector Sachin Waze in connection with the Ambani case. The agency has alleged that Waze was the perpetrator of the offence.

# Senior most IPS officer writes to CM over reshuffle 'injustice'

UPSET AT being overlooked during the recent reshuffle in the top echelons of the Maharashtra Police Force, the state's senior most IPS officer Sanjay Pandey, who was promoted to the Director General of the Maharashtra State Security Corporation rank, wrote to Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray on Thursday, claiming injustice was

meted out to him during the transfer. A 1986-batch pass-out, Pandey said since being promoted to the director general rank, he had not been considered for the posts of director general of police (state), Mumbai police commissioner and director general of anti-corruption and the responsibility of those posts were instead given to officers junior to him.

Pandey did not report to his new office on Thursday. Instead, he wrote a letter to the Chief

Minister, and marked its copies to the home minister and the additional chief secretary of Maharashtra.

In the letter accessed by The Indian Express, Pandey said: "I am anguished to state that for reasons unknown to me, my career as a police officer in Maharashtra state has been purposely blocked. I have for the last several years been bearing out this injustice, but now with your recent orders/actions in the past few months I feel it is just to

place this on record, with a hope that some course correction may still be possible."

"As per my knowledge file for selection of DGP where I certainly have a stake as senior most officer is yet to be sent to the UPSC in spite of a lapse of almost two and half months. This too is much against the principles established by Hon'ble Supreme Court in Prakash Singh case for selection of DGP," Pandey wrote in his letter. He went on to write that he would have understood if

the government considered him as an "incompetent officer". "But on the contrary it was recognising my competence and integrity, from among all the Police officers in Maharashtra, I was entrusted serious confidential enquiries in recent past," Pandey wrote, adding that the state had once wanted him to conduct a probe against senior officer ADG Deven Bharati.

Pandey admitted that he wrote to the Chief Minister but refused to comment further.

# ED opposes cancellation of warrants against Nirav Modi's sister, husband

THE ED has opposed the cancellation of warrants sought by diamantaire Nirav Modi's younger sister and brother-in-law, who had recently agreed to be witnesses against him. The agency has said that the couple should first give a date as to when they will appear before the court and the investigating agency before the non-bailable warrants against them are cancelled.

Purvi Modi, a Belgian national and her husband Maiank Mehta, a UK national, had sought to become approvers by willing to be prosecution witnesses after providing "substantial and important evidence" relevant to Modi and his dealings. The special court had allowed their applications in January, following which they sought cancellation of warrants issued against them in June 2018, as they were declared absconding accused. The two have told the court that on account of the Covid-19 pandemic, there are restrictions on international travel around the world and hence, they are unable to return to the country currently. They had said that they were willing to record their statements with the ED through video-conference.

Special Public Prosecutor Hiten Venegavkar said that till the two appear before the court or give a specific date as to when they intend to do so, the warrants against them cannot be cancelled, though their applications to turn approvers have been allowed.

The court had said that they be brought to court "to take part in the proceedings as soon as may be in the facts and circumstances prevailing currently".
